



COUNTRY UNDER LEVEL 5 RESTRICTIONS

There is a Government Advisory in operation against all non-essential international travel



EXTRA SHORT-TERM MEASURES ON INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL.

- Visa-free travel to Ireland for nationals of South Africa and all countries in South America has been suspended
- Temporarily ceased accepting new visa/preclearance applications globally (with limited exemptions)

NATIONAL FRAMEWORK FOR LIVING WITH COVID-19

The plan sets out 5 levels that correspond to the severity of COVID-19 in a location. Different levels can be in place in different locations in the country.

Every county in Ireland is at Level 5 until 5 April 2021.

NOTES

- 1. You may meet up outdoors with members of one other household but not at home.
- 2. An extended household or support bubble will be allowed in certain cases including for those at risk of social isolation.
- 3. Non-contact training for school aged children can continue in outdoor pods of 15.
- 4. Professional elite sports, intercounty matches, horse racing and greyhound racing may continue behind closed doors.


Entering Ireland from abroad

COMPLETE A COVID-19 PASSENGER LOCATOR FORM

- you must fill in a form before you arrive in Ireland called the COVID-19 Passenger Locator Form.
- Failure to do so is an offence.



- Required to have a negative / 'not detected' result from a pre-departure COVID-19 RT-PCR test.
- Before boarding their airplane or ferry.

Quarantine Requirements

- Introduced for all arrivals from 4
 February 2021
- 14-day quarantine period must be undertaken at the address specified on the Passenger Locator Form
- You must quarantine for 14 days at the place of residence on your Passenger Locator Form. You can stop quarantining once you get a negative PCR test, taken no less than 5 days after arrival

Please note that hiring companies are still asking employees to self-quarantine for 14 days even if a PCR has been taken after arrival.





Persons who started their journey in South Africa or Brazil must complete the full 14 days of quarantine, regardless of whether a negative test result has been received.


Market Situation

Please note as today 07/02/2021 it is necessary to be in the possession of a negative test when arriving to Ireland (ferry or plane) and quarantine for 2 weeks.





New trends in the labour market

High increase on demand for Engineering and Science roles in Ireland as they cannot be filled by local work force.



Shift in the market

There has been a switch in the market toward other sectors that recruit employees with a second European language such: sales, customer service, admin, IT, science and finance.



Jobs with languages

First time jobs abroad for nonnative speakers in hospitality and tourism industries are now not available as result of Covid-19 and current restrictions.




